Scripture: Psalm 34:1-3, 8
Title: "Rejoicing in Restoration"
Psalm 34

1 *I will bless the Lord at all times: His praise shall continually be in my mouth.* This is a Psalm of thanksgiving!

*David has willfully chosen and vowed to adopt a posture of perpetual praise to the Lord. Not that he is claiming to live in a nonstop state of praise. Rather, he is emphasizing that regardless of his current condition, God will be regarded (pay attention to) and not discarded (overlooked).

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***Joshua 1:7 KJV** *Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest. 8 This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success. 9 Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the Lord thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.* (Song: God Will Open Doors by Walter Hawkins)

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2 *My soul shall make her boast in the Lord: the humble shall hear thereof, and be glad.*

*David eventually escapes his perilous surroundings, but he doesn't dwell on his own ingenuity (skill or cleverness). Instead he directs all glory to God.

1 Corinthians 10:13 NLT *The temptations in your life are no different from what others experience. And God is faithful. He will not allow the temptation to be more than you can stand. When you are tempted He will show you a way out, so that you can endure.*

3 *O Magnify the Lord with me, and let us exalt His name together.*

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8 *O taste and see that the Lord is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in Him.*

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*Come, let us dine with Jehovah! Blessed will be those who put their trust in God. For in Him they have been sustained and satisfied. They will walk boldly in contentment because of God. **Lamentation 3:24-25 KJV** *The Lord is my portion, saith my soul; therefore will I hope in Him. 25 The Lord is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul that seeketh Him.* We have everything we need in God.
