

Scripture(s) Hebrews 11 : 8 - 10 (KJV)

Title : "Moving by Faith to An Unknown Address"

Hebrews 11: 8 By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither (where he was going) he went.

Hebrews 11: 9 By faith he sojourned (stay for a time) in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise.

Hebrews 11: 10 For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God.

The book of Hebrews is known as a book of an unknown author. The eleventh (11) chapter of Hebrews is considered the Faith chapter. Our focus will be on Abraham and his driving desire to please God. His time on earth was centered on being faithful in serving God's commands. His walk in the Lord was totally focused and driven in the instructions of our Lord. God told Abraham to leave the environment that he was familiar with. The bible tells us that he did not question nor asked where he was going. That commitment to move and not be concerned with details, is a declaration of someone trusting in the one who sent him. In Genesis 12 : 1 Now the Lord had said unto Abram, get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred (familiar surroundings) and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee. Brother Abram moved swiftly and did not bother to ask questions.

If you were honest to yourself there are countless times when you was asked to go somewhere and before you know it 2(two) hours later and you have not budged. Because you felt you did not receive a reasonable answer is the excuse you reside on.

Maybe that is the reason things are challenging in our lives. God is shadowing over us all to observe if He can use us for His purpose. Isaiah 6 :8 tells us, Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, whom shall I send and who will go for us?

Genesis 12 :2
